In July 2023, the Thomas Hospital Foundation celebrated its 30th Anniversary of supporting the community's hospital.




Since its founding in 2002, the Rileigh & Raylee Angel Ride Foundation has served families of Baldwin County whose children need critical medical care but may not have the financial resources available to cover all their needs. Using a \$100,000 grant from the Angel Ride Foundation, the Foundation will establish a program that can provide financial assistance to Baldwin County families with pediatric patients in need.

The Joseph Treadwell Charitable Foundation committed \$211,000 to the Foundation to enhance the patient experience by installing electronic patient status boards in most patient rooms. Patients can view real-time procedure schedules, care team details, physician updates, care plans, and access MyIHChart directly.

The Foundation's Employee Assistance Grant Program awarded more than \$35,000 in assistance to employees facing a financial hardship.

To meet the ever-increasing demand for cardiac care in the region, Thomas Hospital renovated and expanded its Cath Lab. Already the leader in open-heart procedures in the area, this expansion will ensure patients continue to receive high-quality and timely care when every moment counts.

The Foundation Board made a nearly \$1,000,000 commitment to this project.
