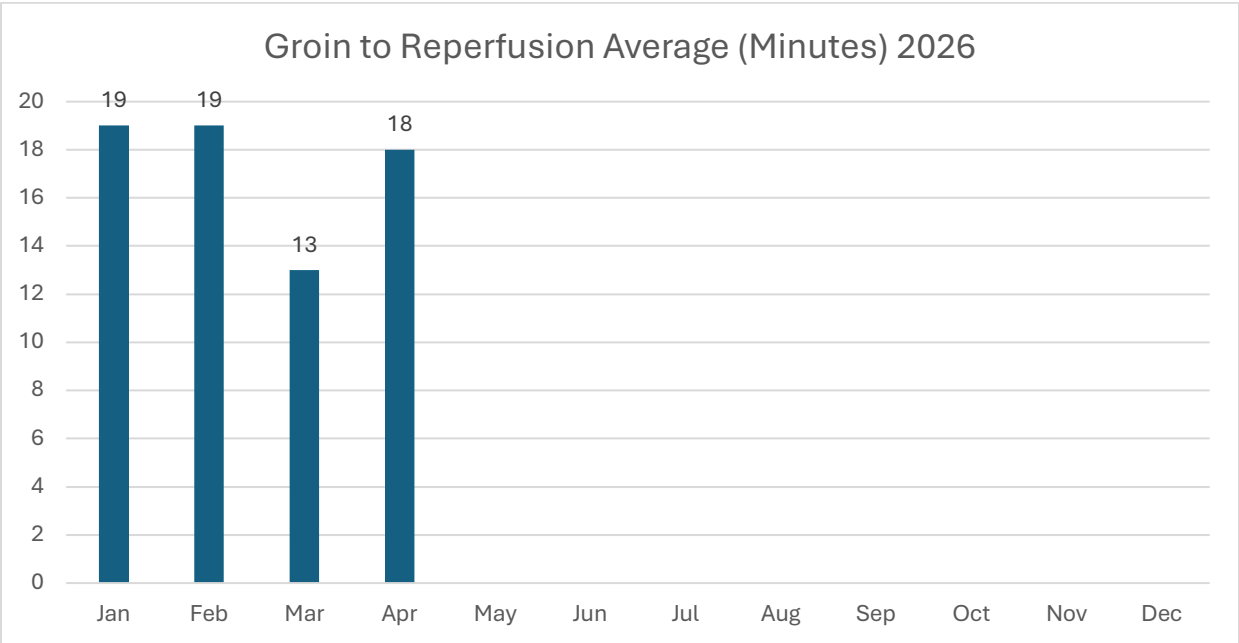
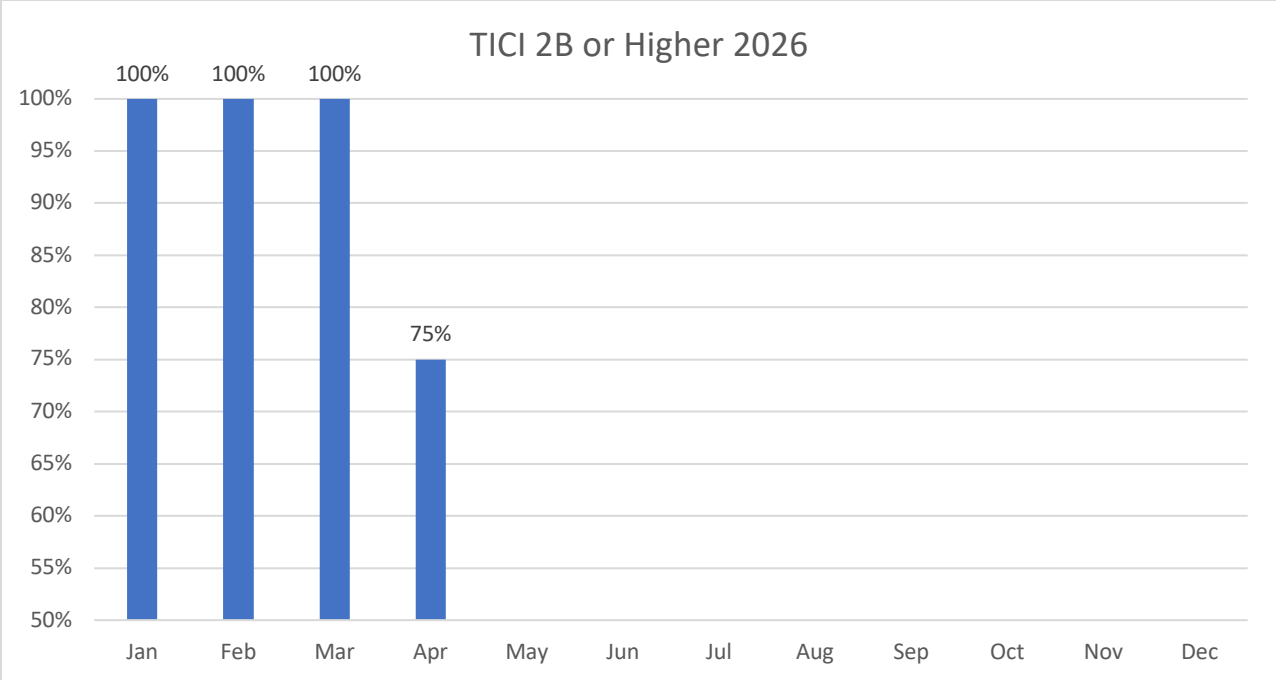


Carotid procedures include carotid stents, carotid endarterectomies, and transcatheter aortic valve replacement.

Stroke can be a known complication of these procedures. This rate should be less than 3%.



Thrombectomies remove large blood clots from the brain when a patient is suffering from a stroke. The goal is to remove this clot within one hour (or less) of groin puncture. Faster times mean the potential for more brain saved.



TICI score stands for thrombolysis in cerebral infarction. Patients who have a score of 2B or higher have complete filling of the vessels. This means the patient has a better chance at recovery after having a large clot removed from their brain.
