WHAT IS CONVALESCENT PLASMA?

Convalescent plasma is the term used for plasma that is removed from the blood of a person who has recovered from a disease, then it is given to a patient who still has the disease.

WHO DOES IT HELP?

Infirmary Health COVID-19 patients who are currently hospitalized due to the virus and to others in need if there is not a matching patient at Infirmary Health.

WHY SHOULD YOU PARTICIPATE?

Convalescent plasma therapy is an experimental treatment being studied through Mayo Clinic that Infirmary Health is using to treat the most critical COVID-19 patients. Your donation could save someone's life.

HOW DO YOU PARTICIPATE?

- Donors must be 17 years of age or older and meet **one** of the three basic qualifiers:
 1. A positive followed by a negative COVID-19 test result
 2. A positive COVID-19 antibody test
 3. A positive COVID-19 test and 14 days symptom free
